

IFC SOCIAL FUNCTION REGULATIONS

1. All social functions must be registered with the Tribal Leadership Center and the University Police Department two weeks in advance of the party date. Chapters must provide security for each social function.
 2. Check ID's at the door and utilize a party list. Party list must be submitted to the Tribal Leadership Center two days in advance of the scheduled party.
 3. Each party must end by 2:00 a.m.
 4. Chapter members and guests must be contained inside the house or in a designated area outside of the house. No loitering in the parking lots or front yards.
 5. Chapter houses and surrounding areas must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. the morning after parties.

Although parties are being allowed to continue within the Fraternity houses owned by the groups, **ALL RULES PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED BY THE ASU ADMINISTRATION IN REGARD TO PROTOCOL FOR PARTIES, ARE TO BE STRICTLY ADHERED.** UPD and Ms. Spack are being provided instructions to shut down any party instantly if any of the rules are not followed to the letter. That includes and is not limited to providing a guest list prior to the party (it must be in order) and anyone found at the party whose name is not on the list in hand, will be grounds to close the party with sanctions forthcoming. Parties not closed down completely by the 2am time frame, will be grounds for sanctions such as canceling parties for the rest of the semester. The two mention are examples of two of the rules most commonly violated. Any of the rules not strictly follow will be grounds for immediate action.
