

## **IFC SOCIAL FUNCTION REGULATIONS**

ALL SOCIAL EVENTS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE GREEK LIFE OFFICE AT LEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO EVENT. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL BE REASON FOR NOT APPROVING EVENT (this includes formal and informal events)

Social functions held during the week are strongly discouraged.

University Police will work all parties on campus at a cost to be covered by the sponsoring group. Two officers will work each party depending upon availability.

The role of the UPD officer is as follows:

- Officers will remain at the entrance to the event. This assists the party monitors with turning away unregistered guests. In addition, chapter members can easily locate UPD officers if an incident should arise where help is needed.
- Officers are there for assistance. The officers at the chapter houses are there for our safety. They are not there to do the job of the chapter party monitors. The chapter party monitors will supervise the social function, not the UPD officers. The officers are simply providing extra security if needed.

Each party ends at 2:00 a.m. with the music being turned off and lights come up at 2:00 a.m. All individuals attending the party must vacate the house no later than 2:30 a.m.

Events are limited to ASU students and their guest. A COMPLETE GUEST LIST (including all individuals attending the party) must be supplied to the Tribal Leadership Center at least two days in advance of the registered party. This computer generated list will also be maintained at the door and each member and guest will sign-in. Anyone not listed on the 2 day prior approved guest list will not be allowed to enter the party. Should someone be found in the party not on the approved list, it will be reason for sanctions and the closing of the event.

All Greek events are limited to only active Greek members included on the chapter roster submitted to the Greek Life office each semester and an additional 40 guests of the chapter. Anyone not listed on the 2 day prior approved guest list will not be allowed to enter the all Greek social function. Should someone be found in the party not on the approved list, it will be reason for sanctions and the closing of the event.

Events for members and dates only will not require a guest list.

A UPD presence at social events does not negate the need for party monitors/marshals. Party Monitors/Marshals MUST be present and wearing identifiable clothing. They are expected to be on duty throughout the evening.

No alcohol may be brought to any event on campus. Alcohol may not be distributed on campus or in organized student housing. Persons of legal age, as prescribed by state law regarding alcoholic beverages, may possess and consume the beverages in the privacy of their own rooms (this privilege is being extended to your registered guest). No cups, cans,

bottles, etc. may be brought into the common areas of your house during a social function. All alcohol is limited to those of legal age in the privacy of their own room.

**Number of social functions:**

Registered events: 3 per semester --on/off campus

All Greek events: 2 per semester—on/off campus

Member/Date: 2 per semester--on/off campus

Drop-Ins: 4 per semester--on/off campus

Hall parties as of this date are no longer permitted.

Social events will not be permitted unless complete compliance with these and other IFC Social Function Regulations previously approved.
