RULE 1. SPORTING INFORMATION, PLAYERS, AND EQUIPMENT

1. **Registration:** Registration for this team event will open on Monday, 2/2 & close on Wednesday, 2/11. Rosters can be turned in at the Intramural office (HPESS 136). Rosters turned in after the closed date will not be added to the playing rotation. They will however, be placed on the waiting list. What does this mean? If a team drops out then we will plug in the first team on the waiting list.
2. **Rosters & limitations:** The minimum amount of players that you need to turn in a roster is one (1). The maximum amount of players that you can have on your roster is sixteen (16). For a player to be added onto your roster the captain must provide the following: Participants proper first & last name (no nick names) & Participants valid ASU ID. During ALL Special Events the rosters will never be frozen!
3. **Starting time & other information:** The Three Point Contest will be on Monday, 2/16 & the Free Throw Contest will be on Tuesday, 2/17 from 4:00 PM – 4:30PM. If you want to see the results on the contest that can only be viewed from one place & that is from the Intramural webpage at <http://union.astate.edu/intramurals>.
4. **Caps:** What is a cap? Cap is the amount of teams that we can allow to participate in an event due to the lack of time & space. Both events the cap is fifteen (15) people.
5. **Rescheduled games:** Games will not be rescheduled since it is only a one (1) day event.
6. **Defaults:** During tournament events teams do not have the luxury of defaulting any games.
7. **Forfeits:** A forfeit is when a team does not show up, does not have enough players to meet the minimum to start a game, or does not make it to there start time. When any of the above happens a team is given a forfeit. A team that forfeits is given a loss, is taken out of league, **AND** is charged a fee of \$20 per forfeit. **IF** a team forfeit's out the season then they will be automatically suspended from registering for all events. If they forfeit another season during that same semester then they will be suspended for that semester. This includes using the team name & suspending **EVERYONE** on the roster. Fees must be paid prior to those participants or team playing **ANY** future intramural events.

RULE 2. GAME FORMAT

THREE POINT CONTEST

1. There will two to four pools & two rounds of play. During round one participant will have 30 seconds to shoot four racks of balls (4 balls a piece). The top participants out of each pool will advance to the next round. If a tie occurs during the round an extra a tie breaker game consisting of 20 seconds & two racks of balls will occur, if there is still a tie then it will be reduced to 10 seconds & one rack. Round two will be repeated as round one had occurred.

FREE THROW CONTEST

1. There will two to four pools & two rounds of play. During round one participant will shoot 20 free throws. The top participants out of each pool will advance to the next round. If a tie occurs during the round an extra tie breaker game consisting of 10 shots will occur, if it still occurs then down to 5 shots until a winner has been declared. Round two will be repeated as round one had occurred.
